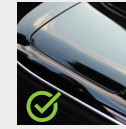

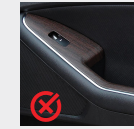
2. Where should you apply ? (interior)



Gloss Panels



Smooth/ Gloss Textured Panels



Textured Panels

3. How to maintain?



After installed. Wait 12 hours before wiping the protected panel.



Simply use water & microfiber to wipe panels.



Avoid using harsh chemicals may damage film layers.



No high-pressure rubbing may lift up film edges.



Clean stubborn stain with alcohol.

4. How to apply installation:

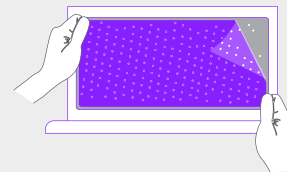
Tool Required : Microfiber Towel | Squeegee | Slip Solution | Tack Solution | Head lamp & Heat Gun (optional)

- 1 Clean & wipe the designated panel.



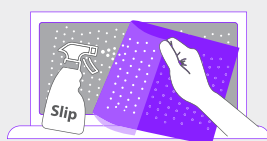
- 3 Lay the film on the panel.

Align the film with more slip solution.



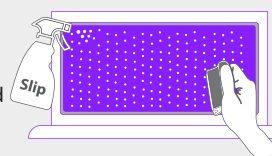
- 2 Mist the slip solution on the panel.

Peel the film off and spray slip solution on the film's adhesive side.



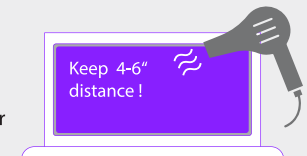
- 4 Wet the surface of the film with slip solution.

Squeeze out water and air bubbles.



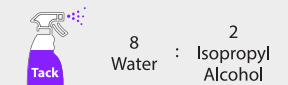
- 5 Allow the film to cure for 3 hours and inspect edges.

For better adhesion, go over edges with a hair dryer.



8 Water : 2 Soap

Slip Solution: add 1-2 drops of baby Shampoo per 8oz spray bottle of distilled or filtered water.



8 Water : 2 Isopropyl Alcohol

Tack Solution : add 9 parts of distilled water to 1 part of 70% or 90% isopropyl alcohol. For more aggressive adhesion, add 8 parts of distilled water to 2 parts of alcohol.
